and one (1) air compressor.

EMERGENCY POWER: A 750 kW Caterpillar Emergency Generator, installed

in 2014, along with a 330 gallon diesel fuel tank.

HEATING: The HVAC system is provided by ConEd Steam.

Steam condensate preheats domestic hot water for increased energy efficiency. Each floor has a reheat

coil for each supply air connection.

The building contains a central chilled water system COOLING:

installed in 2014. Three Trane Centra-Vac-575-ton long barrel high efficiency electric chillers and three600-ton Marley SPX coolers. Chilled water is

distributed throughout the building.

SUPPLEMENTAL AIR: Condenser water available for supplemental HVAC at

building standard rates.

AWARDS: Energy Star Rated (87), LEED Gold, Wired Platinum.

LOADING DOCK: Located on 51st Street.

AMENITIES: On-Site Management, 24/7 Security, Bright Horizons

Day-Care, Messenger Center.

TRANSPORTATION: 575 Lexington Avenue is easily accessible from all

of New York City's transportation hubs through subway service via the E, M, and 6 trains, which are located just outside the Property's entrance at the Lexington and 51st Street Station. Currently this is the only station in Midtown to provide direct access to all three major transit hubs: Penn Station, Port Authority Bus Terminal, and Grand Central. The Property is also ideally located just seven blocks from Grand Central terminal, with access available via the Grand Central North passage entrance only 4 blocks away. The proximity to Grand Central and convenient subway access provides tenants with immediate access to all areas of NYC, including the outer boroughs, Westchester, Connecticut, and New Jersey. The Property can also be directly accessed via the FDR Drive,

Midtown Tunnel, and 59th Street (Queensboro) Bridge. The completion of the Second Avenue subway

line has further enhanced the Property's accessibility.
